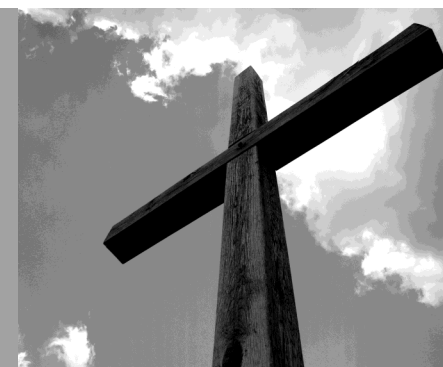

From the Director of Missions:

Great Southern Baptist Convention in Birmingham, June 10-12. A spirit of cooperation and unity was evident. I would like to share a few brief observations. The Convention is getting more diverse – younger people are participating, and different races are as well. Overall, I sense that leaders of the convention are emphasizing what unites us rather than what divides us – that is good. Based on what I observed I would say to you that the Convention's overall direction is toward the Great Commission and Making Disciples. You should feel confident in your support of the Cooperative Program and what we are doing together as Southern Baptists to reach North American and the World with the gospel.

Who's Your One? Johnny Hunt said at the Convention that the average attendance each Sunday is just over 5 million. He said, what if 10% of those in attendance committed to reaching 1 person with the gospel – 500,000 would be reached and baptized. That number would be the highest since the 1940s. Imagine the difference we together could make in reaching DeKalb County with the gospel if 10% of our Sunday morning attendance committed to Reaching One. Who's Your One? May we all do our God-given part and reach the 40,000 without Christ in our county.

Continue to pray for churches doing Vacation Bible School. I've attended 18 to date and have seen good attendance. Pray for the gospel to penetrate young hearts.

Please pray for me and my daughter Abby as we join with other churches in Bogota, Columbia, July 6-13. We will be doing street evangelism with a local church. Thank you and it is a joy and privilege to serve our Lord with you.
